We know you want them quickly, but it's also important that we give you a score that reflects your performance. If you took paper , you can view the results online 13 days after the test date. If you have completed a computer-delivered test, you can view the results online 3-5 days after the test date. We will send a paper copy of your IELTS test score, the Test Report Form (TRF), by post within 13 days of the paper test date and 3 to 5 days after the computer test. You can also request that your results be sent free of charge via courier to local addresses. Php 1,400 fee will be charged for international addresses of the Additional Test Report Form (TRF) authorities We may forward copies of your IELTS results or the IELTS Test Results Form (TRF) to recognise institutions and organisations upon submission of the application form and payment of the applicable courier fee. Courier fees are php1,400 for international address and Php250 for local embassies. Candidates who have used a paid courier service will be given a tracking or air way-round number confirming the TRF delivery. The results will be forwarded within five working days of receipt of the request or within 10 working days for requests paid by a bank deposit. The institutions may review candidates' scores through the IELTS Test Report Form (TRF) Inspection Service. To do this, they will need your TRF number, which can be found in the lower-right corner of your TRF. The period of validity of the authorities in the test report form shall not normally accept a test report form which is more than two years old. After this time, you will need to provide them with evidence that you have passed or improved your English language since the test. Result Query (EOR) You can choose to perform a result query (EOR), which means that your IELTS test will be re-marked if you are not satisfied with your results. This must be done within six weeks of the date of the test. You can choose which test sections you want to re-select. Your test will be sent to the head office to re-select senior examiners. The result request service is charged a fee that will be refunded in the form of a check if your result changes as a result of re-marking. Fees are as follows for each type of exam: £60 for an IELTS test £100 for an IELTS UKVI test £75 for IELTS Skill test Fee multiplied by our monthly accounting rate. To request a re-marking, you can: Send a scanned copy of the completed EOR request form and a copy of the deposit certificate britishcouncil@britishcouncil.org.ph if you want to settle offline. The time of processing of the official receipt shall be five (5) working days from receipt of the detailed requirements. Personally, submit the completed application form, then pay by credit/debit (VISA or Mastercard). Candidates will receive a receipt immediately. Candidates whose marked results have changed should present the original of their results. Their new marked results will be published five (5) working days after receiving the old TRF. On the other hand, return cheques will still be issued two (2) weeks after we receive an official receipt. The new TRF and Return Cheques will be released on the delivery method they advised employees to charge. Requests for results take you from day 2 to day 21. You will be given a score of zero to nine for each part of the test – listening, reading, writing and speaking Learn more about how to understand your IELTS scores and nine-band system. Find out how the IELTS scores relate to the Council of Europe's Common European Reference Framework (CEFR). Can I re-perform the test? You can do the test as many times as you want. However, please note that in order to significantly improve your result, it is necessary to carry out further examination. IELTS research shows that scores are unlikely to improve without further teaching English. You won't have to wait long for your IELTS test results. If you have completed the paper test, you will be able to review the results 13 calendar days after the test date. You can check the results on the Test Verifiers portal. If you have completed a computer-delivered test, you can view the results 5-7 calendar days after the test date. Check the results on the test validation portal. IELTS results remain online for 28 days, but should not be used as an official confirmation of your activity. If you have lost your test report form or if you have forgotten the test results, contact your research centre. When will I get a physical copy of my score? We will send a paper copy of your IELTS test score, test report form (TRF), by post within 13 from the date of the test 5-7 days after the computer test. IELTS results will not be disclosed by phone or email. We will send your Test Report Form (TRF) directly to the authorities you are applying to. Authorities need original copies of your test report form. Photocopies will not be accepted. We may send up to five additional copies of your TRF directly to the authorities you are applying to (e.g. universities, immigration officials, etc.). If you want to do this, please specify the relevant addresses when you have ordered the test. Don't forget to provide your full email address for the institution. Without a full address, we cannot verify that the authority has access to the IELTS Test Report Form Inspection Service, which allows it to review your results after we submit them electronically. If they do not contribute to this service, we will send you a TRF by mail. Can I get additional copies of ielts results? If you want you to send another copy of your TRF to the organisation that recognises it in addition to the five copies we provide, you will have to pay a 20 BHD administration fee per copy to send it to international locations via courier. This process applies to IELTS delivered on both paper and computer. If your test center is closed, you can order additional test report forms from ielts.org. You will need to provide the address of the authority and complete the Application for Additional Test Report form. Attach a photocopy of your IELTS test score and passport to the application form and send it to us bc.enquiries@britishcouncil.org.bh. Then we'll send the TRF directly to the authority. Please note that the additional test report form is processed within approximately 3 days. Request additional copies what does my IELTS score mean? You will be given an IELTS tape score of 0-9 for each test section that reflects your English proficiency. Your TRF shows a score for each of the four skills (listening, reading, writing, and speaking), as well as the overall result of the tape. For each part of the test, you can score the entire band (e.g. 5.0, 6.0, 7.0) or half the bar scores (e.g. 5.5, 6.5, 7.5). Learn more about how your score is calculated. How long do my IELTS results last? Regardless of whether you have used paper or computer IELTS, organizations generally do not accept your results if they are more than two years old, unless you provide evidence that you have actively maintained or tried to improve your English language since the start of the test. IELTS partners cannot confirm the validity of the test results for more than two years. How do I re-mark the IELTS test? If you haven't received the score you'd expect, you can apply for a test to be flagged again. This is called a result query (EOR). You can which test sections you want to re-select and you will need to ask at the test centre where you sat in the test. The fee for this service is BHD 40 (including VAT), which will be refunded if your score is increased for any part of the test. No later than six weeks after the test date, you must apply for relabelling, regardless of whether you took a computer or paper IELTS. Download the results request from the download section below and submit it to the test center where you took the test. Make sure you add a test report form and proof of payment. Studies on the results will take two to four weeks. Can I re-perform the IELTS test? The re-use of IELTS is not restricted. You can order a test as soon as you feel you're ready to do it. Please note that your score is unlikely to increase unless you make great efforts to improve your English before re-taking the test.
